ORDER OF MODIFICATION OF PROBATION ENTERED

The Supreme Court of Tennessee entered an order modifying the probation of a Nashville attorney, George H. Thompson, III, on November 21, 2006. The purpose of the amendment was to extend the probation for two additional years until October 9, 2010.

The original probation order required respondent to make monthly payments of restitution for five years. The Court extended the payments of restitution for two additional years. The order requires respondent to make annual status reports of all payments made to his victims to disciplinary counsel. The reports shall contain a copy of respondent's Federal Income Tax Return for the previous year. Respondent shall remain on probation pending compliance with the modified order of probation.
