To commemorate CASA of East Tennessee's 20th anniversary and to create community awareness in light of the growing problem of child abuse, we are creating the Light of Hope Child Abuse Victims Memorial Fund. These funds will be used for special outreach activities designed to promote awareness and involve more CASA volunteers to serve our children. As part of this initiative, we are commissioning a sculpture, and the planned location is the front of the Carey E. Garrett Juvenile Court Building. We are asking the local legal community to fund this important gift to the community. The sculpture is scheduled to be unveiled during National Child Abuse Prevention Month in April 2008. It will bear the inscription:

*In remembrance of lives lost to child abuse.
In celebration of lives saved through caring.*

The sculpture consists of two children in bronze sitting on a 48" wide triangular base of black granite. The two parts of the inscription will be written across the two angular sections of the front. The names of sculpture contributors and major fund donors, as well as a tribute to Judge Carey E. Garrett, will be inscribed on the backside. Engraved pavers will surround the sculpture.
